Welcome to Kitah Bet!

We have an exciting year planned, full of learning, new experiences, new friends, and fun.

During September, your child will begin to learn Hebrew.

As part of the **first reading unit**, students will learn to:

- Identify the name and sound of the letters (Shin, Bet, and Tav) and the two ah vowels, being able to recognize and blend them together.
- Be able to read the letters in new combinations.
- Print each letter, strengthening their ability to read.
- Understand keywords.

Students will have a **folder** which will contain: reading textbook and/or materials for reading homework assignment and homework assignment page. It is important that the child brings this folder to class every day.

September will also include a **unit about the High Holidays**. The student will:

- Learn the facts about the holiday.
- Participate in the preparation for the holiday through music and art.
- Make the holiday a personal experience by connecting concepts, like new beginnings, to their own lives.
- Do a Tashlich walk. (More information will follow shortly.)
